Lowell Johnstone began to introduce a presentation that he had prepared showing comparisons in dollars spent by C.I.B.C. as per their new hours as opposed to extra hours that we would like to request for Wednesdays. However, Mr. Bill Smith interrupted him to mention that if we were going to rehash what had already been gone over many times, that there was no use, as the decision to proceed with their new planned reduction of services was going ahead. But, he did listen to Mr. Johnstone's presentation, and Council emphasized that a few hours on Wednesday to break up the three-day closure period would certainly be helpful to both residents and businesses of Stanley, plus would no doubt help to maintain accounts with C.I.B.C. that may otherwise be lost.

Village Council submitted copies of their petitions that they had circulated amongst the Village for both businesses and residents, resulting in 590 signatures from local residents and 49 signatures from businesses concerned.

C.I.B.C. representatives advised Council that they are still investigating the possibility of Night Depository for Stanley area, and assured us that they would try to consider our request for some teller service on Wednesdays.

C.I.B.C. commented that they have to give their new plan about a month to see if it is going to work or not before they can anticipate any changes.
