### MET WITH RECYCLING COMMITTEE

Met with Recycling Committee concerning questions they had relating to our constructing a new building on a new site.

Some of these concerns were:

Electricity - fear of being a hangout;

Windows - felt they would like 2 windows so you could see if the light was on or not, but it was agreed that a steel door be purchased with a window instead of the windows in building;

Visibility - the committee felt that the building would not be seen very well because it is going to be tucked in behind the Fire Hall;

Size - the fear that the new proposed size of 22' x 24' may be too small;

Sign - a definite need for a sign to be installed to hang from the Fire Hall;

Storage Area at rear of building would be needed with the construction of a partition;

Security and Maintenance would still fall to the Recycling Committee, and the building will be left open as before;

Need for Shelves for Newspapers;

Repair of Overhead Garage Door;

Would require Bins to be set up as before;

Need for a Dusk-To-Dawn Light;

The cost of the Sign and Set-Up Inside with Shelves, etc. be included in the construction;

Would like Council's support in the future.

It was mentioned that there is supposed to be a Council Member on the Recycling Committee, but a member was not appointed after the termination of J. W. Smith's position as Mayor.

The topic of Christmas Tree Mulching came up and much discussion took place, as Recycling Committee were not in favor of burning trees as was done last year.

The Committee agreed to donate \$500 of their money towards the construction of the new building, but expressed the concern that they required funds for mailout of news letters, etc. They are going to organize a newsletter to the public as soon as the new building is completed.

Village Council and Recycling Committee came to an agreement on all the concerns discussed above, and plans are for Tom Dunphy to continue construction of the building tomorrow as planned.
