5 R.C.M.P.

Cpl Doug Anthony advised Council on the following:

- RCMP went through the School with a Dog in search of Drugs in the School; no drugs found in lockers, but two students were arrested;
- Police Week scheduled for May 12 - 18, 1996;
- A Volleyball Game is planned with the students;
- A Teen Dance is planned to be held at the Lion's Club;
- Dance for Adults in the making;
- Tadd Dance at School to be held next Friday Night;
- Fingerprinting and Videotaping to be organized;
- He stated that Timmy Duguay has straightened up his act, and also reported that he had been to visit Nicky Palmer and given him warnings as to selling drugs;
- Reported that there will definitely be another RCMP house constructed on Alexander Court by July 1996.

Council discussed the change in the speed limit in Cross Creek from 50KM to 80KM. Mayor Ross voiced another complaint that a citizen complained that an RCMP car was in the middle of the road, and travelling at a very high speed when responding to a call.

Discussion took place on our inability to utilize the School for community functions free of charge.

Sonya O'Hara commented on various things happening within the School, some of those being:

1) The Weight Room is going to be used as a Classroom and the weights will soon be taken apart and packed away;

2) Our School has the opportunity to host the Regional Games ( for ages 7 - 14 years) and of attending the Inter-Regional Games. Up to \$3,000 would be given towards hosting these Regionals, and Sonya firmly believes that we could accommodate 7 of the 9 activities involved in these games. She commented that this would be a Village decision as it would involve many volunteers.

Peter Fullarton requested Council's feelings on organizing and arranging for a Beach Volleyball Court to be constructed next to the Tennis Courts. This would provide people of all ages the opportunity to utilize this court and play volleyball all summer, day and night. He stated that Boiestown has such a Volleyball Court and that they have had great success. Council expressed their positive feelings towards such an endeavor.

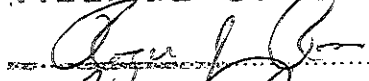
