CHALLENGE PROGRAM - REGIONAL GAMES

HEIDI ANDERSON & MICHAEL GALLAGHER

They gave Council a report on their activities since they began work, and accounted for their time spent when and where. They have recently been using an office at the Villa where they had access to the telephone. The preparations and planning for the Regional Games has occupied most of their time thus far, and reported that they are planning on 180 participants for the Games - 50 from Minto, 45-50 from Stanley, 30 from Harvey, 45 from Boiestown, and 5 from McAdam. Elizabeth Seiffart authorized the lowering of the Registration Fee to \$5.00 per participant, of which Council disapproved. However, a meeting is being held at the School on Tuesday where Ms. Seiffart will be present, and Council will attend to voice their disapproval, etc. At that time, Heidi and Mike will have a Budget prepared including all that they have spent thus far, all that they will be needing to spend, all that they have received, and over all, a summary of everything they

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have done and will do in relation to the Regional Games. They stated that they will also have a Budget from Elizabeth Seiffart. She sent Council a letter this week past in which she stated that they would provide funding of \$2,500.00 for this event.


