4 **RCMP - DOUG ANTHONY**

He reported on the following:

- Just did a Drug Bust in Cross Creek - Mitch O'Donnell;

5 **FIRE DEPARTMENT - P. ZUNDLE**

He reported on the following:

- The Demo on Saturday past was successful, and they will try to do it periodically in the future;
- Asked for financing for full replacement of 1-3/4" hose for Pumper I, approximate cost \$2,400 plus Taxes; they need to have an answer before the end of the month;
- Stuart Smith donated 25 gallon of paint and the dept. asked if Council could supply the labor. Darrel Green will co-ordinate this project and Council will supply the labour of students;
- Asked if Village are covered insurance-wise in case they are accused of being liable in not responding to a fire within the regulation time;
- Requested that Village finance the costs of tests to upgrade the licenses of volunteers', and Village responded in the affirmative;
- Purchased more BA's.

Council agreed to support the costs of the 1-3/4" hose.

## **STRATEGIC PLANNING FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT**

Production of the new Logo is in progress. Received a quote from Barry Reilley for T-Shirts for \$5.50 for 200; quote from Coastal Graphics for \$6.05 for 250 T-Shirts. Barry Reilley also gave us a quote on Village Pins at \$1.60/Pin plus an extra 25 cents if packaged and another 25 cents extra if glazed. Council agreed to order 500 Pins (Bl - 3/4" x 7/8") unpackaged but glazed (\$1.85/Pin) with Crest mounted on Pin, outline in black, and printed in black letters.
