Council agreed to compose a letter to be sent home with the students informing them of a Registration Fee and when it is to be paid, but will wait until after Monday's Meeting with Elizabeth Seiffart, in hopes that she can shed some light on this approach. Council's suggested letter would read that "Registration will be held on the evening of June 18, 1996 from 7:00 - 9:00 PM, and on June 19, 1996 from 9:00 - 5:00 PM. A Fee will still have to be determined.

Councillor Barb MacDonald asked Council if they would be willing to accommodate the labor of Edison Palmer in order that he decrease the amount of dollars owed to the Village on his Sewage Bill. Council agreed that he be hired for a Contract Price to cut bushes from proposed extension of Walking Trail, and Clerk will issue cheque to Mr. Palmer, he will in turn sign it and return it to Clerk, who will receipt him for the same amount towards his Sewage Arrears.

MOTION: Council agreed to purchase a new Push Lawnmower, and Councillor Mark Foreman will investigate the market and obtain a price.
