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FIRE DEPARTMENT

Later on in the meeting, Jerry Kennedy, appeared on his way home from writing an exam, and advised that he had received a price of \$1,100.00 for getting the Fire Truck ready. Also, he asked if Council would like the new logo installed on the Fire Department vehicles. Council agreed but wondered if he would want to put the entire logo on it or not. Crib Tournaments are now in question as David Green does not want the commitment of giving up every Saturday, and no one else has volunteered their time for same as yet.

16 CANADA DAY


